July 3 at 1 & 7 PM **Let There Be Light:** 100 minutes – world famous atheist Dr. Sol Harkens delights in debating and defeating Christians, is emotionally empty. Isolated from Katy, the wife he divorced following the harrowing loss of their first son, and a lousy part-time dad to their two younger boys, his self-destruction culminates in a car crash that leaves him clinically dead for four minutes. The four-word message from that experience challenges his convictions, sending him into a panicked tailspin. 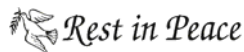
