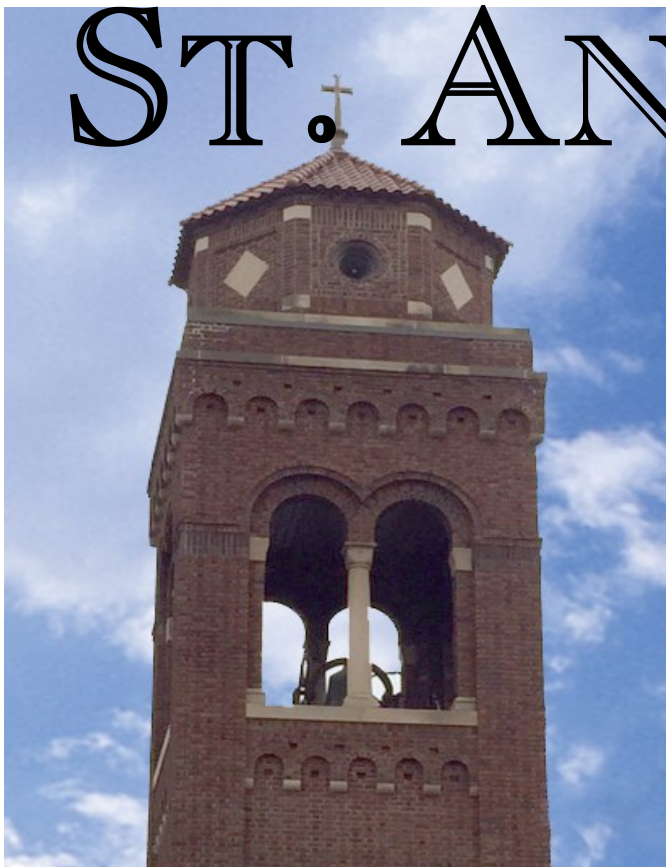

Today, we welcome **Fr. Bernard Osei Ampomg (Fr. Ben)** who will preach about the Church's missionary work in the Diocese of Obuasi, Ghana, West Africa. This annual appeal, gives us a meaningful opportunity to support Christ's Mission-especially by helping form seminarians, catechists, and other lay leaders who serve their communities with faith and dedication.

The Diocese of Obuasi is largely rural, and many families live below the poverty line. Communities often lack basic pastoral care, educational facilities, healthcare, and clean water. To meet these needs, the Diocese drills boreholes, builds clinics and hospitals, and strengthens school facilities-but limited resources make it difficult to continue this essential work.

A **second collection** will be taken at all Masses this weekend to support this mission. Your generosity-no matter the amount-can make a real difference in the lives of the poor and vulnerable. Please give as you are able, and keep the people of Ghana and all missionaries in your prayers. Thank you for your support, and may God bless you abundantly.

JULY 13-THE COURAGEOUS HEART OF IRENA SENDLER- 6:30 PM-8:05 PM

One of the most remarkable and most unlikely heroes of World War II, saving 2,500 Jewish children during the German occupation of Poland. As a social worker, Irena had access to the Warsaw Ghetto, making it possible for her to rescue the daughter of a Jewish friend and safely hide the young girl with a Catholic family.

Realizing that thousands of children were still in danger, Irena recruited sympathetic friends and co-workers to smuggle children out and place them in safe homes, farms and convents. At great personal risk, she devised extraordinary schemes to sneak the children by Nazi guards, bringing them out in ambulances, suitcases and even wheelbarrows.

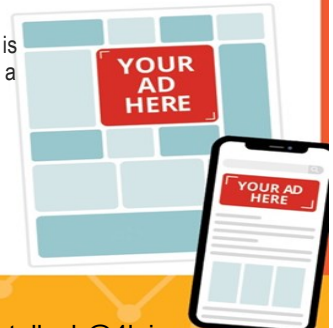
