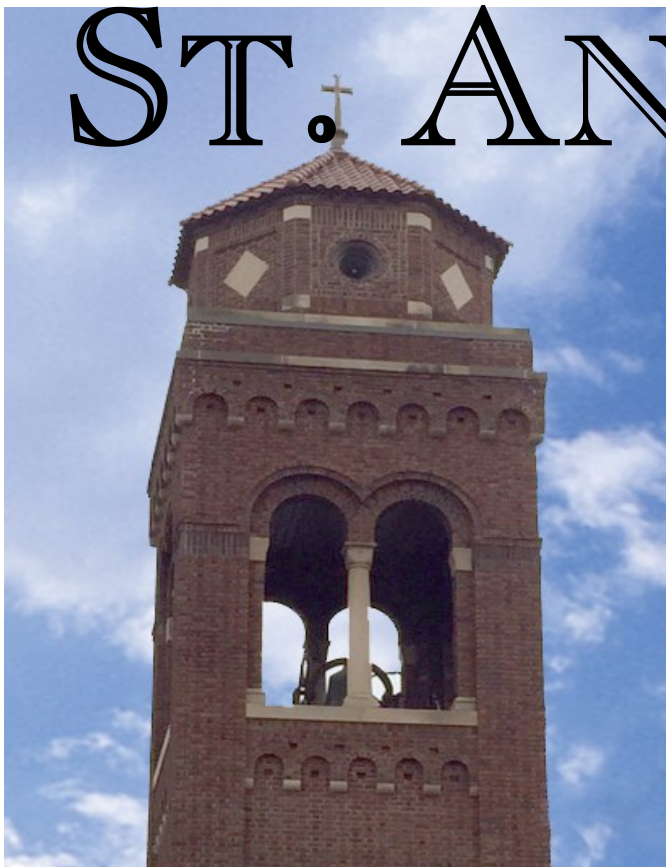

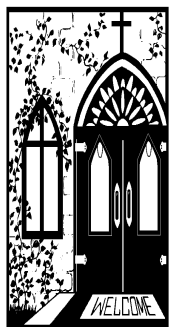

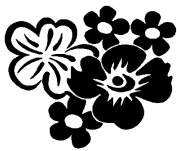
A Call Out for Home Visitation Ministers

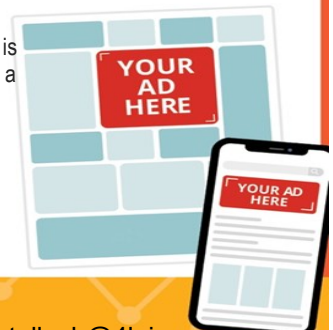
