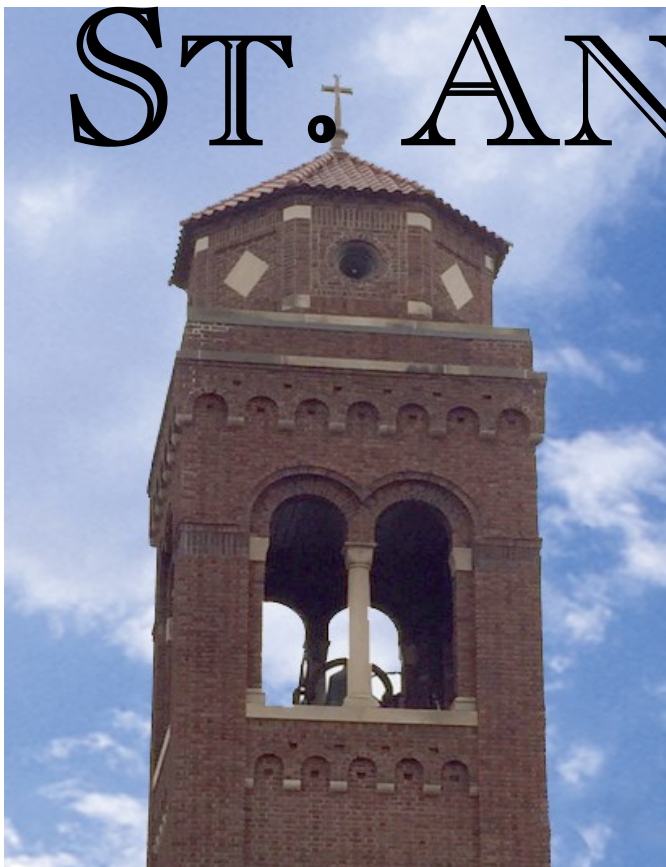

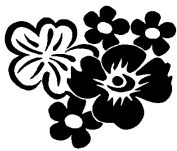
PETER'S PENCE COLLECTION

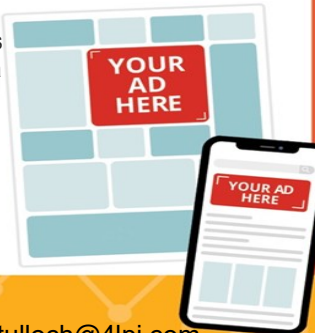
Looking for Summer Care?
