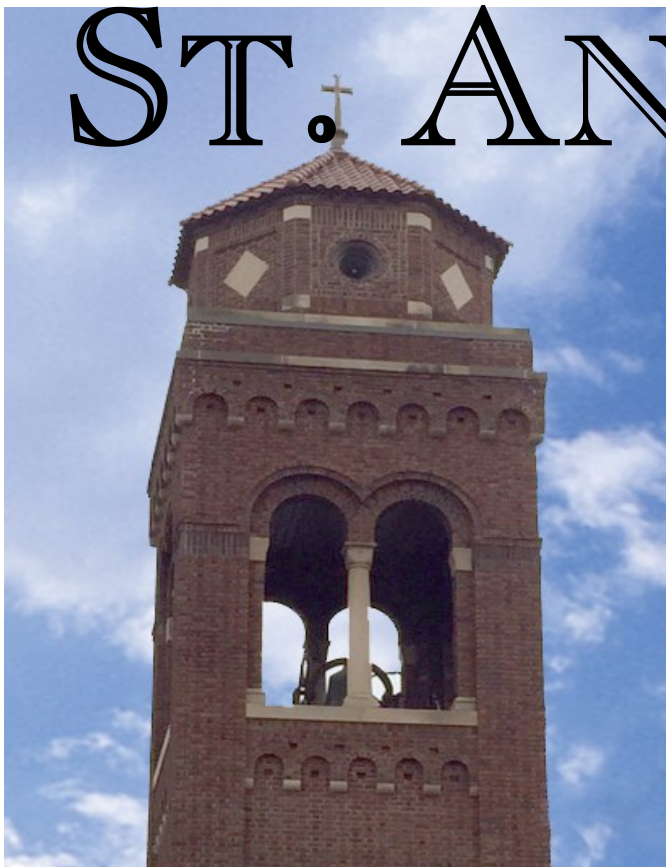

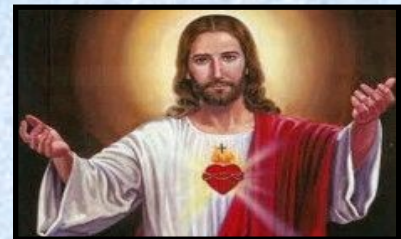
21st Annual Little Italy Street Fest
